28. Chase the dolphins and whales, cruising beautiful Jervis Bay Marine Park
29. Experience a part of history, catch a flick at the Husky Pictures built in 1913
30. Swim at any time of year in Bomaderry Indoor Heated Pool
31. Catch a movie at one of the cinemas in Nowra, Huskisson, Sussex Inlet or Ulladulla
32. Visit Meroogal, an Historic Houses Trust property, built in 1885 and preserved with an exceptionally rich collection of four generations, Nowra
33. Visit the site of an old gold mine at Yalwal, 28km south-west of Nowra
34. Take a drive to Kangaroo Valley to photograph the historic sandstone Hampden Suspension Bridge
35. Admire the spectacular coastal cliff views from historic Cape St George Lighthouse, Booderee National Park, Jervis Bay
36. Stroll along the shady tree-lined boardwalks of Booderee Botanic Gardens, Booderee National Park, Jervis Bay
37. Visit historic museums at Berry, Kangaroo Valley and Nowra
38. Treat yourself at the Treat Factory, Berry
39. See "Hanging Rock" and cross the suspension bridge on Ben's Walk along the Shoalhaven River
40. Play bingo and housie at various venues
41. Take the car ferry to Comerong Island and enjoy the nature reserve flora and fauna
42. Experience the thrills and challenges at one of the Skate Parks located at Berry, Nowra, Sanctuary Point and Ulladulla
43. Grab some binoculars and head out early to view any of the 200 species of birds that inhabit Booderee National Park
44. Enjoy horse riding through bushland at Kangaroo Valley, Falls Creek, Milton or Termeil

47. Visit and learn all about emus at Marayong Emu Farm, Falls Creek
48. Tempt your literary tastebuds at one of the Shoalhaven's great public libraries
49. Stroll to Granite Falls, Morton National Park and enjoy the wildflowers in season
50. Enjoy fish and chips at Greenwell Point while you watch the antics of the pelicans.
